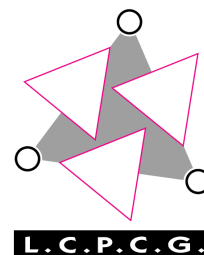

1.	<p>Meeting Details</p> <p>The Safer Lewisham Partnership (SLP) is responsible for tackling crime, disorder, anti-social behaviour and drug misuse in our borough and includes Council; Police; and other local organisations</p> <p>http://www.lewishamstrategicpartnership.org.uk/partnership_safer.asp</p> <p>Every year, the SLP must consult the community for views on what Lewisham's priorities should be in their efforts to reduce crime and disorder. The SLP's Strategic Action Plan from 2011/12 http://bit.ly/ygfrv2 shows how last years priorities were developed into actions. This year, following discussions with the LCPCG, they introduced an online Crime Survey which widened public access to the consultation and had a very good response. This survey ran in January and February 2012 but has now closed.</p> <p>This workshop is being run for the LCPCG's members and associates by officers from the council's Crime Reduction Service. We will receive early feedback from the Lewisham Crime Survey and other information which is being collated to inform the SLP priorities .
