#### **Notes**

This meeting was a discussion based event, part of the consultation process for Safer Lewisham Partnership's (SLP) Annual Strategic Assessment and was led by their officers. These notes serve only as a simple record of the event for the LCPCG's own purposes.

During the first part of the meeting, Arseny Barkovskiy of the Crime Reduction Service gave a presentation on the findings to date from the 2012 Lewisham Crime Survey – which had 555 responses - and some of the other findings which will contribute to the Safer Lewisham Partnership Strategic Assessment.

Following that there was a mature and in depth debate between those present, covering a very wide range of issues around safety and perceptions of safety in the borough.

These included anti social behaviour; knife crime; successful work targeting criminal gangs; cycling on pavements; potential legal changes in how local authorities can deal with problem neighbours; dog fouling and park patrols; fly-tipping; the Lewisham Youth MARAC; the HEART Programme; causes of crime and social responsibility; street robbery; cowboy builders and theft by deception; and much more.

5 feedback forms were collected from attendees. Written feedback included "best part was to hear about audience's views" "Presentation on Survey results was rather difficult to understand" "Workshop was useful session to involve everyone and possible ways to over come problems such as anti-social behaviour" "Very constructive meeting".
