## Interested in joining the Downham Assembly Coordinating Group?

The coordinating group involves at least one ward councillor, one resident and one representative from the local third sector. The coordinating group is appointed from the wider assembly, and anyone who lives, works or learns in the ward can sit on the group. Additional members may be co-opted between appointments. Ideally the group should have between 6 and 12 members.

The group helps to plan and structure assembly meetings to ensure the smooth running of the meeting and to ensure there is a diverse attendance from all parts of the local community

Roles and responsibilities of coordinating group

Plan the agenda for each assembly meeting.

Provide advice on how to make assembly agendas relevant to the different communities in your ward and make sure meetings are planned to make them accessible and enjoyable.

Assist, where possible, in the practical delivery of assembly meetings.

Consider approaches to be used by the assembly in recommending the allocation of the Assembly Fund  
Assess funding applications to ensure they meet the assembly's criteria.
