1. Assembly Fund marketplace and voting

There were 19 community projects bidding for a portion of this year's Assembly Fund. A total of £18,200 was available. Each project had a stall around the main hall upstairs at the Deptford Lounge, where they could answer questions about their projects and show people what their organisations do for the local community.

Please see the 'Assembly Fund Pack' document for a description of all the projects.

Everyone that attended that lives, works or studies in New Cross Ward was given a voting sheet to score the projects out of 5 (1 for the lowest score 5 for the highest). The voting finished at 8pm and the scores were then counted. 190 people casted a vote.

2. Assembly Fund results

The scores were counted, and the results were announced at the end of the meeting, with the projects ranked in order with a cut off point where the the less successful projects didnt receive funding.

The following projects were successful in receiving funding (project 3, Family Services UK received a reduced amount).
