## **1. Summary**

- 1.1 This report informs the Mayor and Cabinet of the comments and views of the Housing Select Committee, arising from discussions held on the Select Committee Work Programme item considered at its meeting on 6 March 2013.

## **2. Recommendation**

- 2.1 The Mayor is recommended to note the views of the Housing Select Committee as set out in section three of this referral and agree that the Executive Director for Customer Services be asked to respond.

## **3. Housing Select Committee views**

- 3.1 On 6 March 2013, the Housing Select Committee considered a report entitled *Select Committee Work Programme* that advised the committee of the work programme for the municipal year 2012/13 and asked members to suggest items for inclusion on the 2013/14.
- 3.2 The committee noted that some residents had raised with them their concerns that the ongoing Housing Matters consultation process is not giving equal consideration to the two remaining options.

## **5. Legal Implications**
