**Report Title**    **Outcome of Secondary Transfer Process for admission in September 2011 and Equalities Impact**

1.    Purpose of the report

The purpose of the report is to inform the Forum of the outcome of the secondary transfer process for Lewisham pupils transferring to secondary school in September 2012.

2.    Policy Context

The previous School Admissions Code charged the Admissions Forum with considering existing and proposed admission arrangements and assessing how well they serve the interests of local parents and children.

3.    Recommendations

It is recommended that the Forum particularly considers

- 3.1 the outcomes for Lewisham secondary schools, in terms of their intake in each band and the number of pupils who made each school their first preference;
- 3.2 the outcomes for Looked After Children;

4.    Background

This report sets out the customary information provided in the annual monitoring report. This includes the applications to and acceptances at each Lewisham secondary school, the outcomes for pupils.

## 5 Analysis

- 6.1 **Table A** details the number of children each school admitted and for this particular year no schools admitted pupils exactly in line with their banding formula. In accordance with the School Admissions Code, vacancies in a given band must be offered to pupils in an adjoining band. Therefore it is difficult for the numbers to tally exactly when a school is undersubscribed. Usually, schools under recruited in band 1a. In particular Consiborough College (-13), Deptford Green (-23), Prendergast Ladywell Fields (-39) and Sedgheill (-48) were most affected.
- 6.2 Details are given in **Table B** for the acceptances at each school in terms of how many were first preferences, second preferences, and so on. These figures relate to all applicants, not just those living in Lewisham.
- 6.3 Although it is possible for a pupil to be offered any of their six preferences, the advice given to parents by the Admissions Team is that if they want a particular school, they should put it first, and not risk being offered a school they prefer less. Those who are admitted to a lower preference school have often made an unrealistic higher preference, for example where the child lived outside that year's qualifying home to school distance.
- 6.4 Schools with vacancies have been offered to any applicant still seeking a place. The authority and the Forum do need to be mindful of the impact on those schools of significant numbers of 'in year' (casual) admissions during the course of the school year.
- 6.5 There were 10 Looked After Children living in Lewisham and the details of the school they were offered is presented in **Table C**. All of these children were offered their first preference school.  
There were 10 Lewisham looked after children living out of the borough. Of these 3 had a statement of SEN, the remaining 7 were offered places via the home LA's admission scheme.
- 6.6 There were 9 children who were not offered one of their preferred schools (**Table D**), did not accept a school offered to them and did not apply for any alternative. Places are still available for them at the schools that have vacancies, and attendance enquiry letters have now been sent to the parents of these children.
- 6.7 Figures about the outcome of appeals appear in **Table E**. It is worth noting that, as a result of the multi-preference system, the number of appeals continues to decrease. The highest number of appeals heard was again for Haberdashers' Aske's Hatcham. There were 39 appeals heard compared to 71 heard for the school in 2011.
- 6.8 **Table F (a)** details the number of children transferring into Lewisham schools from neighbouring LAs. The number for 2012 (325) is similar to the number transferring in 2011 (327).

Table F (b) details the number of children living in Lewisham who transferred to schools in other Local Authorities. Again the number in 2012 is similar to that in 2011(735 in 2011 and 737 in 2012). The number peaked in 2010 with 784 children transferring out of the borough
