- ❖ 78 people including children with their parents
  - ❖ Approximately 1/3 were young people
  - ❖ 84% had not attended an assembly before
  - ❖ 18% of those of voting age were not registered to vote and 5% did not know

- ◆ 28 new people on the mailing list
  - ◆ Provided information & signposting to services
