

PROPOSAL TO REVOKE DECISION TO EXPAND ADDEY AND STANHOPE SCHOOL

Notice is given in accordance with Section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013/3110 that Lewisham Council intends to revoke the decision to expand the permanent capacity of Addey and Stanhope School (New Cross Road, London SE14 6TJ) from 4 forms of entry (120 pupils in each year) to 6 forms of entry (180 pupils per year), utilising the site of the Mornington Centre, Stanley Street, London SE8 4BL
