## 1. Summary

This report informs members of the questions put forward to be addressed by transport providers and the Committee.

1. Given the proposals to truncate some bus routes, will the present arrangement regarding "two buses within an hour for the same fare" be retained and extended to say "all buses within a period of 90 mins". This would help to cover the extra period of waiting for the next bus, and moving from one stop to another eg at the Elephant interchange. **(Geoffrey Thurley, Ladywell Society)**
2. Elderly residents of The Woodlands SE13 and Stainton Road SE6 feel they are no longer provided with an adequate bus service to and from Catford Town Centre and beyond. My understanding is a number of bus routes have been removed from Brownhill Road (A205 the South Circular ) over recent years. Some, but not all, have relocated to Sandhurst Road/ Sangley Road which is some distance from the new bus routes. Please could we have an understanding of which routes have relocated, to where , the rationale for the relocations and if the impact of these relocations have been or are to be assessed. **(Cllr Patrick Codd)**
3. In terms of issues, concerns re 273 Hoppa bus - appears to be a reduction in time table - mainly serves Lee, Grove Park, but runs from Tesco's in Lewisham as far as Petts Wood. Raised by residents. **(Cllr Hillary Moore)**
