New Premises Licence Application – Chicago Grill Plus, 315 New Cross Road, London, SE14 6AS

Please be aware that on behalf of The Crime, Enforcement and Regulation Service I provide notice of my objection to the new premises licence application in relation to the above mentioned premise.

It has been necessary to object to the application at this stage as The Crime, Enforcement and Regulation Service are currently investigating possible unauthorised licensable activity at Beirut Canteen, 303 New Cross Road, SE14 6AS.

This is considered relevant as the Director, Mr Nader Said-Nassirzadeh, of Beirut Canteen Ltd, the premises licence holder in relation to the above mentioned restaurant is the named applicant in relation to the new premises licence application at Chicago Grill Plus, 315 New Cross Road, SE14 6AS.

It is in the opinion of The Crime, Enforcement and Regulation Service, necessary in line with the promotion of the licensing objectives most notably in this instance the prevention of crime and disorder to object to the application at this stage as a means of enabling officers to complete their investigation in relation to the matter.

Additionally, this provides officers an opportunity to also assess concerns that the premise subject to the application traded in excess of its permitted hours of licensable activity on Sunday 14th October 2018, where it is alleged that sales occurred in excess of 03:00am, the hours authorised via the application of a prior temporary event notice. It is also alleged that the premises were open and that sales occurred in excess of 03:00am on 12th October 2018. This is all currently under investigation.
