Overall comments/Recommendation

Total score 30: the application is not recommended for funding.

The organisation is well run and delivers excellent activities in the borough. However, Lewisham benefits from a wealth of organisations providing similar activities and it is not possible for the Council to support all of them financially. Difficult decisions have to be made in the context of cuts to the Main Grants budget and other applications have present a more compelling case and broader range of service impacts.
