a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

This is a general store with off sales. The risk assessment below reflects the steps to help uphold the licensing objectives for this area.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system to the satisfaction of the police. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available upon reasonable the request of Police or authorised officer in accordance with the Data Protection Act throughout the preceding 31 day period. A CCTV monitor screen shall be displayed in full view of customers.

A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises is open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show Police recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.

Any staff directly involved in selling alcohol for retail to consumers, staff who provide training including managers shall undergo regular training of the Licensing Act 2003 legislation. The training shall be documented and signed off by the DPS and the member of staff receiving the training. This training log shall be kept on the premises and made available for inspection by police and relevant authorities upon request.

c) Public safety

An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available for inspection on request to an authorised officer of Harrow Council or the Police, which will record the following:

- (a) all crimes reported to the venue
- (b) any complaints received
- (c) any faults in the CCTV system
- (d) Any refusal of the sale of alcohol
- (e) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
