Recommendation

To consider the decisions made by the Mayor and Cabinet on 14 January 2004 which will come in to force on 27 January 2004 unless the Panel objects and calls them in.

On 14 January 2004 the Mayor and Cabinet made the following decisions:-

- 1. School Organisation Plan Draft Fifth Edition Submission to School Organisation Committee
 - 1.1 <u>Summary</u>

This report sought agreement following public consultation to the submission of the draft of the Fifth School Organisation Plan to the School organisation Committee for approval.

1.2 The Mayor and Cabinet agreed that the draft of the Fifth School Organisation Plan appended to the report be approved for submission to the School Organisation Committee.

2. Local Management of Schools - Scheme Amendments 2004-05

2.1 <u>Summary</u>

This report sought approval to amendments to the Local Management of Schools Scheme (LMS) with effect from 1 April 2004, subject to resources being made available as part of the budget process.

- 2.2 The Mayor and Cabinet agreed that the following changes which were set out in paragraph 4.8 of the report be approved subject to resources being made available:
 - formal inclusion of nursery schools in the formula
 - integration of class size grant into the formula

- funding of pupils attending FE institutions agreed that the proposal be deferred until the next scheme review to enable further discussion on the number of pupils involved
- three year budgets and school balances agreed, subject to further discussions on the treatment and use of school's balances
- SEN and AEN funding mechanisms agreed the proposals for a specialist teacher for the deaf and the revised arrangements for dual placements. The wider proposal implies a consultation during 2004 on changes to the formula with the aim of implementation in 2005-06
- funding of schools within federations agreed that a contingency sum be set aside pending a review of the impact during 2004-05
- funding of pre-exclusion intervention.
