3. Background

3.1 The Constitution provides for the membership of the Overview and Scrutiny (Education) Business Panel and the Children and Young People Select Committee to include 2 x diocesan representatives and 3 x parent governor representatives – one for primary schools, special schools and secondary schools.

Recommendation

To consider the decision made by the Mayor and Cabinet on 8 September 2004 which will come in to force on 21 September 2004 unless the Panel objects and calls it in.

The Mayor and Cabinet on 8 September 2004 made the following decision:-

1. Consultation Outcomes - Brockley Admissions Limit

1.1 Summary

On 7 April 2004, the Mayor agreed the admissions arrangements for the academic year 2005/2006. At that time the report advised that the admissions limit for Brockley required further consultation in response to the Governing Body's request that the admissions limit be reduced. The outcome of the consultation was presented in this report.

- 1.2 The Mayor and Cabinet agreed to the issue of a public notice presenting the proposals to reduce Brockley's admissions limit from 60 to 30 from the beginning of the academic year 2005.
