A5	Beckenham Place Park	<p>Resolved: that the Committee's views be referred to Mayor and Cabinet as follows –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Committee welcomes the ambitious plans for the future redevelopment the park and it also welcomes the greater opening up of the park to the local community.</li> <li>• The Committee requests the financial management plans for the project, including the projections for the annual running costs for the park once the project is complete, be made available for scrutiny.</li> <li>• The Committee notes the potential for large overruns on major regeneration schemes and recommends that Mayor and Cabinet seek assurance that there is tight financial management of the project.</li> <li>• The Committee expresses concern over the five year wait regarding plans for the long term future of the mansion house. It would welcome the publication of the advice from the Heritage Lottery Fund, which has informed the development of the current approach.</li> <li>• The Committee recommends that a management plan for dealing with large crowd events be published and implemented.</li> <li>• The Committee believes that that management plans for the park should include the requirement to recoup the cost of staging large events from promoters.</li> <li>• The Committee recommends that any plans for events or activities held in the park, for which there will be charges, are priced so that there is a reduced cost for residents of Lewisham.</li> </ul>
