<p>A4</p>	<p>The Rutlands, Rutland Walk, SE6 4LG</p>	<p>Having considered the presentation of Lisa Hooper, Crime Enforcement and Regulation manager, and the objections as stated by PC Butler on behalf of the Metropolitan Police Licensing team (Lewisham), Members were unanimous in issuing a counter-notice against the TEN application submitted to the Licensing Team on 15th September, preventing the event fixed for 11th October at The Rutlands, Rutland Walk SE6 4EG.</p> <p>Members based their decision on the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) the absence of the Applicant to present their TEN application and/or answer questions in relation to objections raised by the Metropolitan police; and 2) the Applicant had failed to address Members' concerns around public safety, i.e. to comply with current Covid regulations and a failure to engage with ESAG to provide information around stewarding and management of persons attending the event (to assist in identifying steps were undertaken by the Applicant to guarantee the safety of participants attending the event). <p>For these reasons, Members were of the view that the Applicant had failed to provide information/evidence to satisfy them that the licensing objectives, namely the prevention of crime and disorder and of public safety, would be met and therefore, agreed to prevent the event from going ahead on 11th October.</p>
