A3	Silks 177-181 Rushey Green SE6 4BD	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On 11 March 2024, the Metropolitan Police (“the Police”) submitted two applications for a summary review of two premises licences – “Silks 1” and “Silks 2” – in respect of the same premises: Silks, 177-181 Rushey Green, Catford, SE6 4BD (“the Premises”). 2. The Licensing Committee held a remote hearing to consider what interim steps (if any) it should take in response to the applications. The hearing was attended by the Police (represented by counsel) and the PLH (also represented by counsel). 3. Having considered the evidence and submissions, the Committee’s decision was to modify the conditions of both licences as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the opening hours of the Premises on Friday-Saturday shall be 09.00-01.00; and (b) the sale of alcohol on Friday-Saturday shall be 09.00-00.00. 4. This decision takes effect immediately. The PLH has the right to make representations about the interim steps the Committee has taken. If representations are received, a hearing will be held within 48 hours to consider them. The summary review hearing will take place by 9 April 2024.
