- This is an application to be determined under section 153 Gambling Act 2005 and the relevant principles to the applied set out in that section ' *in exercising their functions a licensing authority shall aim to permit...*'
- 2. There are currently three betting offices on Deptford High Street. Two are operated by Paddy Power and one by JenningsBet at 14 Deptford high Street. There are no Casinos.
- 3. They used to be seven betting offices on Deptford High Street issued under the Gambling Act 2005 but William Hill have closed two shops (38/40 and 206) Ladbrokes have closed one shop (48/50) and Coral have closed one shop (70). There has been a reduction in the number of betting offices number on Deptford High Street. Two of the closed shops have been replaced by Amusement Arcades.
- 4. JenningsBet at 14 Deptford high Street has not had any of the issues referred to in the eight representations.
- There are no objections to this application from the Metropolitan police, licensing authority, public health or other authority and no evidence is put forward against the licensing objectives by any authority.
- 6. A full range of policies and procedures including a detailed operating strategy was submitted with this application and is submitted for this Licensing Committee Hearing.
- The policies and procedures, training and operational strategy of Jennings at all times promote the licensing objectives and ensure that none of the concerns of those making representations relate to JenningsBet premises.
