## 1. Chairs and Vice Chairs of Select Committees

The constitution requires that the Chairs and Vice Chairs of scrutiny select committees are allocated on a proportional basis based on party strength on the Council.

The current party composition of the Council is:

There are currently six permanent select committees. The option previously applied was to make two separate allocations of the six Chair and Vice-Chair positions.

## ALLOCATION

The Council's previous practice has been to make two separate allocations. This was last reviewed in November 2012.

The allocation for both Chairs and Vice-Chairs now would be as follows:
