1 SUMMARY AND PURPOSE

- 1.1 This presents the London Borough of Lewisham's Audit Plan for year-ending 31st March 2016. It provides an overview of the planned scope and timing of the audit, as required by International Standard on Auditing (UK & Ireland) 260. The document is designed to help Panel members' understanding the consequences of Grant Thornton's work, discuss issues of risk and the concept of materiality and to discuss areas where members may request that the auditors to undertake additional procedures.
