Annex 3- Condition attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of a Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Local Authority or Police Officer throughout the preceding 31 day period. The CCTV system should be updated and maintained according to police recommendations.

A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises are open to the public. This staff member must be able to show a Police or authorised Council officer recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested

A proof of age scheme, such as Challenge 25 shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence or passport holographically marked PASS scheme identification cards.

The premises licence holder will not permit alcohol to be consumed outside the front of the premises.

An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised Local Authority or Police Officer, which will record the following:

- a) all crimes reported to the venue
- b) all ejections of patrons
- c) any complaints received
- d) any incidents of disorder
- e) any faults in the CCTV system
- f) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
- g) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service

Sales of alcohol shall not be sold, supplied or consumed on the premises otherwise than to a person who is also consuming a substantial table meal and provided, always, that the consumption of alcohol by such persons is ancillary to taking such meals.

No person under the age of 18 will be permitted on the premises after 21:00 when on sales are permitted unless they are in the company of an adult and are consuming a substantial table meal.

As soon as possible, and in any event within 1 month from the grant of this licence the premises shall join the Safer London Business Partnership, a local crime reduction scheme approved by the police.

The garden at the rear of the premises shall be closed to all members of the public from 21:00 each evening.

No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to nuisance.

Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and businesses and leave the area quietly.
