The following data is based on the NPS London Divisional Caseload on the 23rd November 2018.

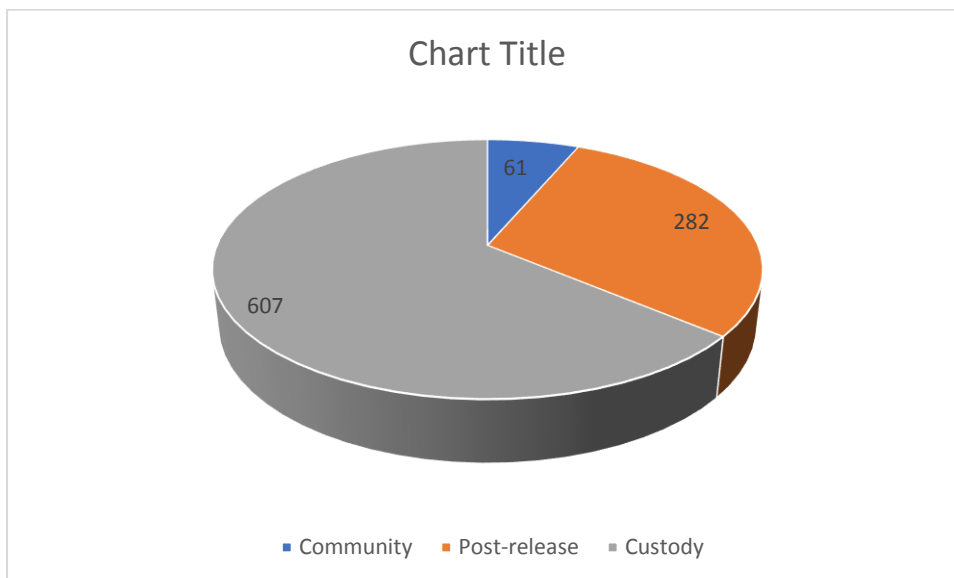
1. Order Category

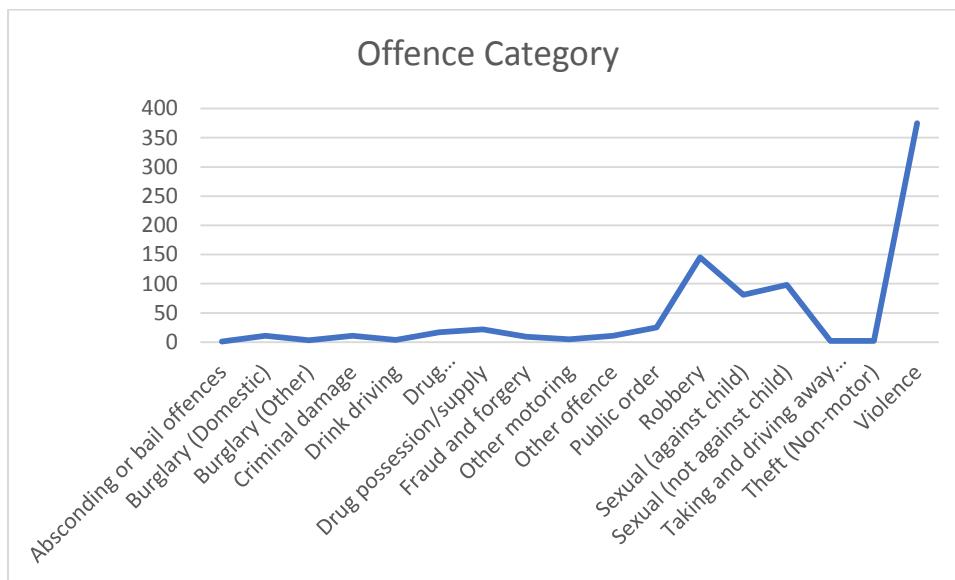

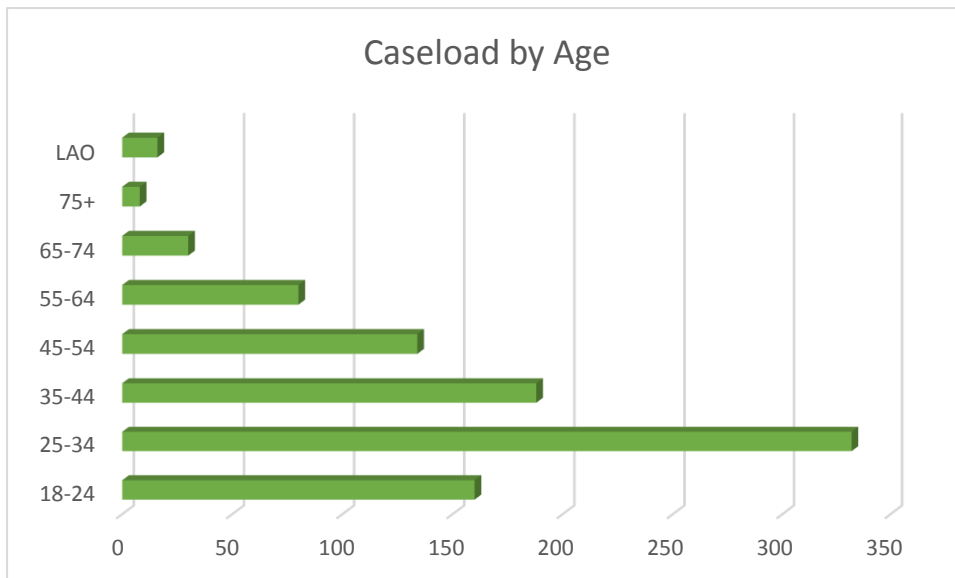

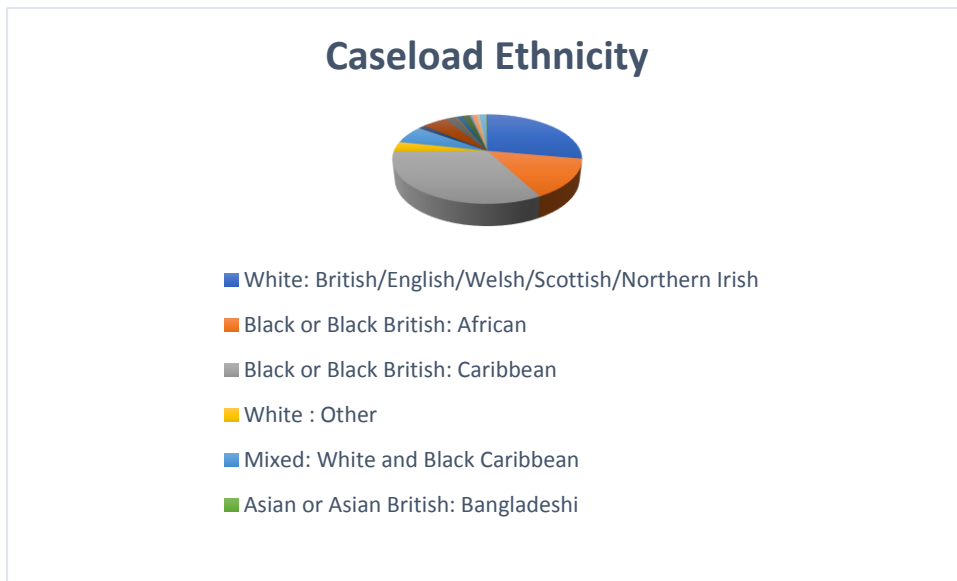

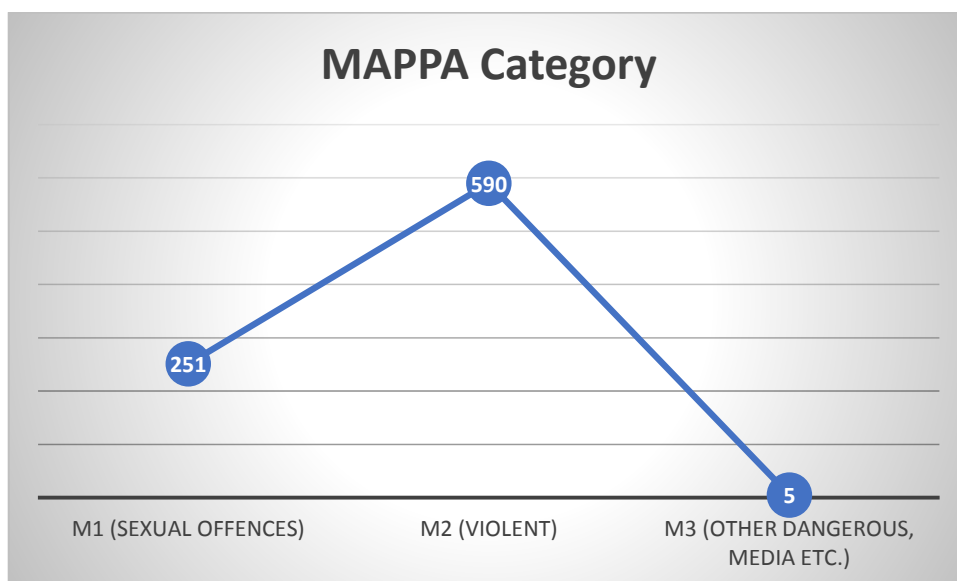


6. Caseload MAPPA Category

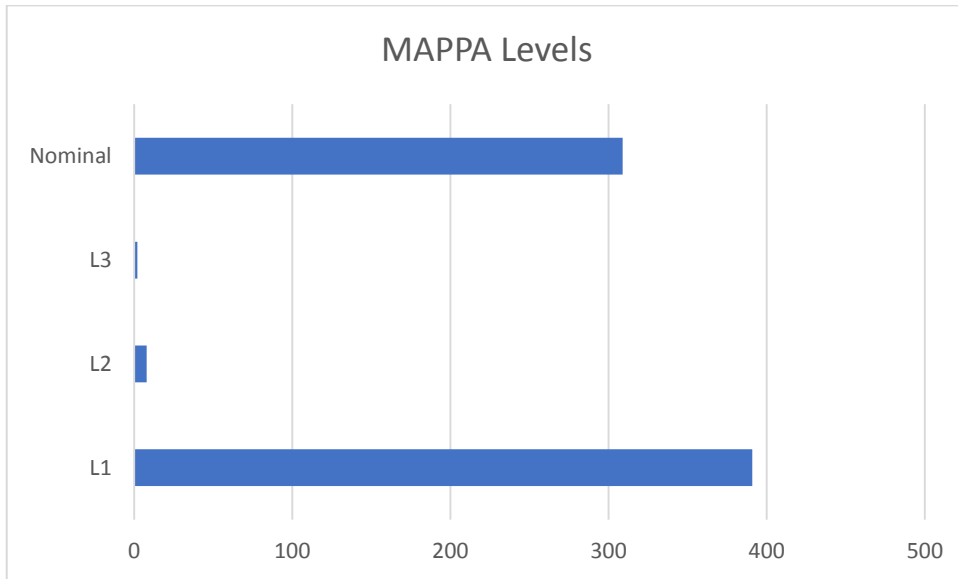

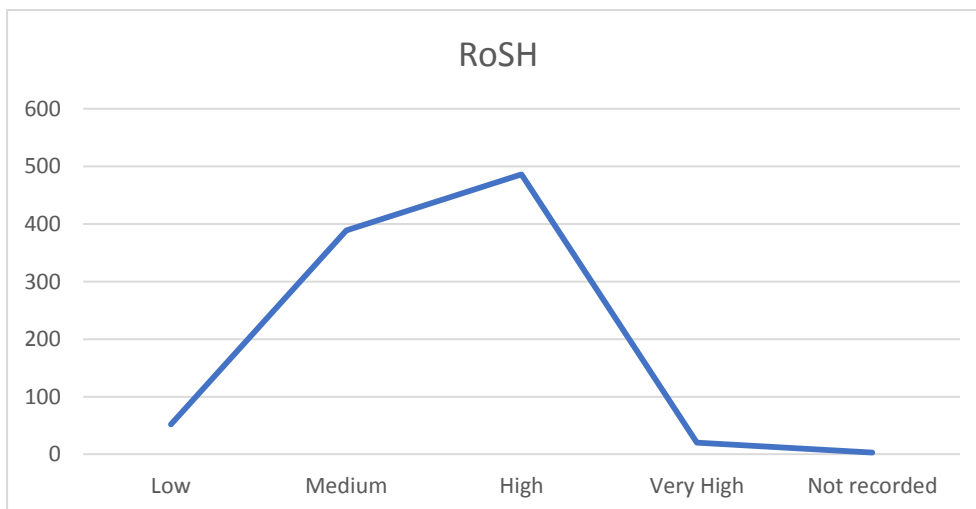

12. Psychiatric problems

Significant problems

- Evidence of current psychiatric problems, which are severe and well-documented over prolonged periods of time
- Psychiatric problems are more than likely linked to offending
- The offender is receiving medication or other treatment

Some problems

- Evidence of psychiatric problems
- Have disclosed psychiatric problems, but the duration and whether they are in current treatment may be unknown
- There is no immediate link to offending behaviour
- Has been recommended for psychiatric assessment or oversight but results are not available
