Protection

- Fire Safety Advice, Guidance & Enforcement
 - Team of specialist Fire Safety Officers.
 - Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005
 - Fire station teams support low risk buildings.
- High-Rise Visits
 - Grenfell Tower vast number of resulting remedial works.
 - Resulted in temporary changes to fire related plans & procedures.
 - Fire station crews repeatedly visit at set intervals to:
 - Familiarise themselves with the building & arrangements.
 - Ensure 'Responsible Person' is adhering to requirements & procedures.
 - Ensure held data is accurate & up-to-date.
 - Provide reassurance to residents.







Response

- 1st January 2021 1st January 2022
 - 3,858 incidents.
 - 482 were fire related.
 - 1,510 were 'Special Services'.
 - 1,866 were false alarms.
- Operational readiness is the priority!
 - Theory & practical training at station.
 - Large-scale training exercises.
 - Revalidation of skills and qualifications Training Department.
 - Maintain equipment & resources.
 - Undergo periodic quality assurance assessments.
