- . Prevention of Public Nuisance

Near close proximity to residential properties and will cause a public nuisance operating 11pm to 4am. There will be noise nuisance, during applied hours of the licence. Also with those vacating the premises, during the night and particularly at closing time.

- Prevention of Crime and Disorder

High possibility of anti-social behaviour due to the late night/early morning of operation. No control of patrons when they leave or vacate the premises.

Generally the hours which have applied for are too long and 7 days a week is far too great for an establishment in such close proximity to residential properties.
